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Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sow." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Aquarius

You had a history of being an individualist. One of your key impulses was experimenting with new ideas. Your soul was normally exhilarated about reincarnating, anticipating the surprises with enthusiasm. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be an innovator. A crucial lesson was to avoid being different just to be different. Maintaining a clear sense of direction with purposeful actions was a better way to conduct business. Keeping a detached mental objectivity helped you clarify your decisions.

When you let your heart speak rather than your intellect, people found you more approachable. Toning down your aloofness in favor of becoming more personal helped you make important social connections. A trickster was looking for too much attention, searching desperately for acceptance. It led to great uncertainty, and letting others dictate too much of the action. Then again, you could go to the other extreme, becoming too overpowering and demanding. Finding a way to balance being a free spirit and fitting into someone else's kingdom was a key to stability. You needed to be your own person, choosing to reinvent yourself now and then. Electricity was ignited when venturing out beyond your comfort zones and testing the waters that pointed to new creative directions. Also, when you fell in love with a person or other heartfelt pursuits, the magic took over.

Node in 4th house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? Developing your intuition was vital to staying clear about the choices that confronted you. If you grew too controlling, your key objectives often stayed just beyond your reach. A common concern was "how can I best establish a sense of security? When you reflected before taking action on a well-conceived plan, you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Finding the right home that protected your privacy, and even symbolized your beliefs, was an energizing force. You liked the feeling of witnessing the first step toward a new milestone. Preserving certain rites and rituals brought out feistiness. Your energy levels peaked when beginning in a new direction. Becoming comfortably stuck in the same roles is what stunted your growth. Fueling your life with greater emotional closeness and with ties that made

you feel needed, added extra meaning. When you let yourself trust someone special, this kept you on track as much as hiding in isolation depressed your mental disposition. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks was a nurturing instinct mixed with a tinge of being a loner. When using this wisely and perceptively, life was colored with a greater wholeness, and a sense of feeling connected.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Sagittarius:

The sign of Sagittarius, the archer, lighted the late-fall astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Sagittarius is "I understand". You had a repeating pattern associated with a quest for expanded self-discovery. A thirst for knowledge hits that Sag arrow right on the mark. You often pulled adventurous ideas from your mental quiver. Looking for the roads less traveled spoke to the gypsy in you.

Archetypes for Sagittarius include the teacher, student, philosopher and even a clown. You looked for the ultimate meaning in things. The disappointment painted on your face showed when encountering shallowness in people, and especially that found in society's institutions.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your lives was to avoid commitments until ready to settle down. In other words you may have retired first and gone to work later. You were more fun to be around when you didn't become dogmatic. When you were truly able to agree to disagree, life was more fun. Your sense of humor kept the heavy stuff in perspective. A never-ending positive attitude allowed you to climb high mountains. Of course there were a few journeys that after halfway, you wished you hadn't begun. Blind faith did lead you astray. You found ego strength through developing a powerful belief system. The traveler in you was a strong theme. Past lives witnessed you covering many miles whether through the mental or physical levels. You have come into this life solarized through a sign promoting expansive thought. This was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and was a key to self-mastery. It was when you took that leap of faith, fueled by clear reason that you accomplished great things.

Sun in 7th house

You had solar power heavily directed into your relationships in previous lives. Partnerships played a big part in your happiness. You had to decide just how much time and energy this part of life was worth investing. Your creative vitality was sparked through interacting with others. A rich social life was a repeating theme. Living alone wasn't considered your first choice. Marriage and living with lovers was a strong trait. Attracting dramatic and lively types occurred frequently. You were happy when your accomplishments made people proud of you.

If there was a challenge it was staying balanced in romances. You were tempted to overly compromise in order to please people. You were better off when standing your ground and making sure it was a fifty-fifty proposition. The diplomat and mediator shined brightly through you. Your self-expression was heightened through the encouragement of close allies. The world responded positively to you when acting decisively, and didn't know how to define you when

you were lost in indecision. You found fulfillment when in love with someone accepting you as you were, and when your deepest fears didn't derail you from reaching out to your ambitions.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Pisces:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Pisces. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual capacity to put your imagination to powerful use followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a desire to dream of a better tomorrow.

Your inner landscapes were colored with keen intuition. Tuning into events before they happened did occur. This was a side of yourself not revealed to everyone. You enjoyed escaping from reality through travel, dreaming and creativity. You had a strong idealism. Unrealistic faith in people did get you into trouble. You were a natural romantic not really paying attention to your boundaries. When you did find real love, it felt like heaven. You looked for lovers sharing your values. There was a quietness about you that was a watcher of people, reading their facial expressions. Art and music became passions. You didn't always like to talk through vocal chords, but more so through creative expressions. Love went to extremes. Falling in love with individuals running away from reality eventually showed you this wasn't the road to happiness. You were at your best when having the faith to take on new challenges.

You loved the ocean and found water very healing. There was great sensitivity to the energy of a location. You were somewhat mystical in some lives, even downright psychic. You liked stable lovers because they were grounding, but didn't like controlling types. You often made your work your cause, or searched for directions that made you feel useful. Your subconscious called to you to find meaningful love, and to look beyond the surface of things into their deeper symbolism.

Moon in 4th house

You had intuitive power when it came to survival in past lives. A sixth sense for knowing how to preserve your sense of well being was highly developed. You instinctually knew how to time a change so that it would give you a greater sense of security. It wasn't that you relished giving up what you had, especially if you liked your lifestyle, only that you wanted to be ready to ride out any potential upheavals. Part of you always feared the worst in order to be able to accept the harshest reality. Family concerns played a major role. First and foremost, you loved feeling needed! Being a caretaker or nurturer was a role in which you were often cast.

Home was something you treated as sacred ground. You had territorial needs that had to be respected by others. Your loyalty to those you loved was a stabilizing factor. Your moods were a barometer of your feelings. Turbulent emotions could find you vacillating from smiles to frowns quickly. An inner feeling to break free from the expectations of those from your past did surface occasionally. Dealing with controlling authority figures was usually when this tendency was the strongest. You repeatedly lived in locations offering comfort, safety and by all means, privacy.

Ascendant: Persona, Identity, Calling Card

Gemini on Ascendant:

With the sign Gemini as your past lives Ascendant, moving in a few directions simultaneously often colored your incarnations. The mental side of life was usually well developed. Your perceptions of people were startling accurate. Your nervous system tended to live on the edge. Sometimes it was due to a compulsive desire to devour as many experiences as possible to the point of mental exhaustion. You appreciated people with intelligence. You grew bored with people taking too long to make a point. You enjoyed clear communication. Sitting still for long periods of time made you uneasy. Looking out with a pair of curious and eager eyes colored your incarnations. An inner restlessness was an integral part of your mental chemistry. It usually played a major role in motivating you to seek change. Others saw you as intelligent and as thinking fast on your feet. A challenge was learning how to stay focused. A tendency to change directions quickly sometimes interfered with your being able to stick with long-term projects. You displayed a fast and creative mind.

The Quest

Mercury: Communication, Perceptions and Logic

Mercury in Capricorn

You were Mercurialized at birth through the sign of Capricorn pointing to pragmatic mental impulses in past lives. Your communication style was business-like and thorough.

You had a sense of the bottom line quickly after entering a negotiation. A too serious disposition did alienate people. You needed to exercise care that a failure didn't cause you to become depressed. There was a tendency to become too attached to success. Managing your time efficiently did allow you to get a lot done faster than most.

A lack of flexible thinking caused you to have communication difficulties. When you spoke with conviction and listened with an ear of sincerity, others warmed up to you in a hurry. You had a mental toughness that didn't let obstacles stop you. Your mental outlook was brighter when you took the time to enjoy the moment and found the confidence to try new endeavors.

Mercury in 7th house

Your perceptions moved gracefully, looking to lead you to a state of balance as often as possible. Conflict wasn't enjoyed. Running away from problems made them bigger, and prolonged the agony. You diplomatically looked out at the world, deciding how to please others, and yet reach a few of your own milestones. Your mind was constantly searching for reliable partnerships. You didn't need anyone only interested in changing you into someone you were not.

You were attracted to lovers able to speak clearly and treating you as an equal. Indecision was nerve wracking. When you moved forward and didn't worry, things usually fell into place quickly. In acting decisively you found your mental power. Learning how to create win-win situations was important.

Venus: Relationships, Values, Comfort.

Venus in Scorpio

With the love goddess adorning you through the sign of Scorpio at birth, you came from past lives where you expressed intense passion and emotions. Many people experienced you as symbolizing secretiveness and mysteriousness. Your social instincts were shaded with a hue of charisma and an interest in what was really motivating others.

The ideal soul mate was someone with the same desire to bond on the most intimate of physical and psychological levels. You were attracted to lovers that you felt could be trusted. Why? Because you felt betrayal was a slow type of death. You grew possessive of those you loved, as they did of you. Your relationships were taken seriously. Even friendships were highly valued. Jealousy did manage to occasionally interfere with your happiness.

Your survival instincts were out in front of most. It was the pain of rejection that was your Achilles heel. You did eventually learn that falling in love didn't guarantee permanence. Venus in 8th house

Romance bordered on the extreme in that you weren't always interested in passive lovers. You liked those with a true sense of intrigue. Your own mysterious energy led you into exotic encounters. When love came too easy you didn't always appreciate it. Growing too attached to someone sometimes was troublesome. You had strong survival instincts. You were attached to privacy and having financial freedom. When individuals respected each of these sacred grounds, you felt valued. Pointing the way to greater empowerment for those you loved meant a lot to you.

Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

Mars in Libra

What would a warrior planet in the airy sign of Libra mean regarding your past lives? You welcomed those moments when you were decisive. The agony of weighing options played upon your consciousness heavily. It was easier to please yourself than others. Your initiating impulse was lit when you were inspired to act by a lover, or when you were pursuing to own beautiful things. A competitive streak was awakened when you felt others were taking advantage of you. You expected to be treated with fairness.

Your identity was attached to finding a lover and soul mate as part of the same package. Romantic individuals had a way of getting you to slow down and smell the roses. Your pace vacillated abruptly from very fast to very slow. This was due to forgetting to rest, so eventually you dropped from exhaustion. There were lives where you learned how to pace yourself. You were at your best when finding the paths that presented you with enough stress to test your mettle. You didn't really like to prolong angry disputes as it made you feel uneasy. Having Jupiter, the planet of good fortune, in the sign of Scorpio indicates that you were excited by exploring mysteries. You liked the challenge of figuring your way out of problems. You chose to expand your potential through anticipating ahead of time how to be prepared for a crisis. Knowledge in your eyes was power. Taking the time to learn what others sometimes judged as obsolete went in your favor. Knowing your way around the business world was of great interest. You were an introspective student that required peace and quiet to think straight. Researching your favorite subjects was a lifetime passion. If there was a downside it was that you doubted you had the ability to recover from a crisis. The interesting thing is that when you managed not to let your fear get the best of you, an incredible inner strength shined through. A refusal to give in to negative thinking was empowering. Luck came by way of persistence that you would reach your desired life aims. A positive attitude helped you consistently turn negatives and setbacks into winners. You found confidence in seeking allies that really believed in you during the rich and lean seasons. Travel was a way to process experiences. When maintaining a broad perspective, you never felt like you were missing out on any of life's opportunities, and more magically found happiness. Staying away from jealousy and manipulation was a test.

Jupiter in 8th house

A positive and enterprising outlook influenced you to look for profitable alliances. You felt great if you managed to pull off moving in multiple directions successfully. Although there were times when you regretted not focusing on one major undertaking at a time. Losing important confidantes or romantic partners through not paying attention to them did get you thinking about your priorities. A tendency to be too secretive distanced you from others. Spontaneity in tempting fate, or even living in dangerous situations, made you feel refreshed. Learning to keep life simple proved a wise alternative. Getting lost in compulsive desires needed to be kept in check. A powerful rejuvenation of energy followed when you turned things around. Good fortune came through having the wisdom to know which belief systems would expand your options.

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Taurus

Ambition came forward slowly but surely, says your past history, with Saturn placed within the calming sign Taurus. Discipline was usually preached to you early in life. It wasn't wise to force you to be something you really didn't want to be. You were serious about money. This means you knew quickly that few things came without a price. Business sense was in your veins. Some accused you of being too cautious. Moving with a steady pace toward success was your style. You were willing to work hard, but you didn't like everyday hassles. Your greatest fear was whether you could find the love and sense of well being you desired. When you satisfied this dilemma, you were then able to proceed ahead with less anxiety.

A karmic shadow was getting lost in either material desires or having a poverty consciousness. When you mastered this dilemma, you enjoyed greater balance. You often defined yourself through solid professional aspirations and as someone determining the best way to dig in and ride out life's storms.

Saturn in 2nd house

Where was your main focus? It was with your money and possessions. You consistently asked at crucial points during an incarnation: how can I solidify my earning power? Whether rich or poor, you wanted control over your finances. Rigidity concerning your values or ownership produced karmic woes. The antidote was more flexibility in these areas, that is, when you were determined to be successful in not repeating the same old lessons needing to be learned.

A shadow was a fear of poverty and losing what you loved. Clear definition in how to earn a living at something you enjoyed, was a preference. You sometimes embarked in directions more to please others, than yourself. A major redefining related to your priorities happened during lifetimes, often when you fell in love, or when losing what you were most attached to. Wisdom came through conserving your energy and developing a steady determination.

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

Uranus in Libra

You had a tendency to weigh the consequences of future goals, indicates Uranus in the sign Libra. Your mind did switch to fast forward when you made a clear choice that you knew would bring you beneficial results. Your social life was as stimulating as they come. Being out in the public made you feel alive. Being a loner wasn't likely, unless you became so eccentric

that you alienated others.

Inventiveness was triggered by your partnerships. You found confidence in sharing your unique ideas. Your insights into the legal arena and the arts were powerful. Trusting your own discoveries was the real test before you talked yourself out of them. Maintaining a sense of direction kept you decisive and guided you toward doors that offered fulfilling relationships along with energizing new experiences.

Uranus in 9th house

In what way were you unconventional? It was in the area of your highest beliefs. Your mind didn't care for limits, which got you into trouble now and then. You had futuristic vision when it came to sensing opportunities in greener pastures that allowed you to reinvent yourself. Restlessness needed to be channeled productively. Your goals were many and quite elaborate. The challenge was in knowing which to follow and when. A sense of direction changed as often as an unpredictable tornado, aligning itself with whatever was currently running through your mind. Your interests were numerous and eventually you tried to narrow the field. You were eclectic for the most part. Argumentative as well. Freedom was defined by you as spontaneity. You didn't like your ideas to be questioned. You tended to rebel against limited minds and against those trying to impede your personal progress. Your ideals were sacred possessions that you didn't like infringed upon. You didn't like to look back at the past as it interfered with your momentum. You didn't find compromise something that came easily. Also, you fought the thinking of someone else if it wasn't congruent with your own. You sometimes became judgmental or preachy if you thought your own truths better than that of everyone else. You were inventive when developing an expansive plan that gave you a chance to incorporate all of your ability.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Sagittarius

You believed in ideals that took your imagination skyward. Your idealism was awakened through traveling to learning terrain, foreign to your upbringing. A burning exploring nature guided you to navigate the deepest waters of adventure. Inspiring others to look for greater truth was a natural part of you. You did need to be careful in not getting lost in unrealistic aspirations. Education was boring if it was too ordinary. You had the intuition of a dreamer, but could get down to business once you found the roads that gave you focus. Romance was forever pulsating through your psyche. Lovers with a stomach for flowing with spontaneous chasing of a new cause usually went over big with you. You liked finding a romantic partner sharing many of your highest values.

Neptune in 8th house

Challenging relationships particularly intrigued you, as did mysterious lovers. You became mesmerized when investigating subjects considered off limits by society. There was an interest in trying forbidden material. Your idealism caused you to go way over the edge when it came to love. There was heartache when it came to finding a suitable soul mate. There was an inner toughness in you that lay underneath your outer persona. You didn't fear the trouble that falling in love could bring. Though your partners could be weak willed, not having your strength. Commitments were not necessarily sought after, unless you were really sure about someone.

A test was not surrendering too much of your power to someone you idealized. You could give up your wealth and logic if you fell head over heels in love. Self-mastery came when you felt the inspiration of your beliefs. Your spirituality gave you the fortitude to resist giving into your adversaries, when you knew you were serving your highest values. You sometimes got clearer in knowing who was worthy of your trust. What was the biggest challenge? You had to beware of running away from emotional closeness and fearing to find out your own shortcomings. Faith transformed your denial into personal empowerment. You searched for a purpose that left you the option of rebirth.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion**Pluto in Virgo**

Empowering yourself through using analytical ability was a past lives tendency. Perfection drove you on to try to do great things. Being reasonable in your expectations was wise. Extreme worry was sometimes a downfall. Curbing this tendency did make you happier and allowed for greater productivity. Charisma was exhibited through working forcefully at whatever you made your life mission. Escaping into projects made you less nervous. There was a habit of putting your heart and soul into a cause.

There was a shadow. What was it? Criticism. You could spot if something was out of place in a second. You did at times overly pick apart yourself or others. When you got this one under control, good fortune was never far away. Self-mastery was discovered through deciphering the ways to work smarter rather than harder. You found rebirth or a sense of fulfillment when overcoming negative thought patterns, and seeing that altered perceptions were truly miracles.

Pluto in 9th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? It was through maintaining a broad-minded vision of what you were trying to accomplish. You were emphatic about keeping your options open. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through venturing out into territory that was foreign to your normal way of learning. Whether being educated traditionally or unconventionally, you had a passionate yearning to put your knowledge to work. A powerful self-examination manifested itself when your faith in yourself or others was shattered by a

calamity. You had to regain your resolve to move on. Making peace with the past usually paid dividends later. Relocating was sometimes your way of starting over. A compulsive tendency to put all of your eggs into a single dogmatic philosophy did make you difficult to tolerate. If you alienated too many people, this got you to ask thought-provoking questions. You were easier to like when accepting views that didn't always agree with your own. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations: running from commitments. It doesn't mean you never were successful in this area. It is only saying there was an impulse to sometimes leave if people wanted you to come closer. When you faced your fear, relationships and other life roles were more enjoyable.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon trine Mars

Tuning into your anger helped you steer clear of causing trouble. You preferred people that didn't make themselves a disruptive nuisance. You might have been emotionally intense, but this wasn't so easily seen. You liked competition because it awakened your drive. It wasn't the winning that was as important as the momentum it created. You didn't mind challenges as long as they fit neatly into your life.

Moon square Neptune

You had a strong tendency to ignore reality though this doesn't necessarily mean the news was all bad. Some of your greatest accomplishments came through testing the utmost limits of

your imagination. The muse consciousness regularly called your name. An intense desire to master a creative expression occurred frequently. Yes, you were a dreamer. This caused you to ignore many of the warning posts signaling that maybe you were swimming out into treacherous waters. A wish for escape made you try to do things others shied away from. Tasting the best that life had to offer was another offshoot. A battle with extreme pulls toward perfection and denial had to be won. The search for the ideal love was on early. Though you were happier when realizing that all relationships took work. Having clearly defined boundaries was a test.

Moon conjunct Node

You relied on your intuition a great deal to make sure you were walking your talk in harmony. The natural forces of the universe tried to reveal their presence to you. Why? So you would remember that you were not alone. There was a protective energy around you, guiding you toward the paths that brought an inner sense of security. Romance made you feel more whole. Though you needed to be sure not to depend too much on others. You found balance through self-reliance. Staying focused on your objectives was the way to success.

Moon square Ascendant

You were an emotional force in the lives of those you loved, sometimes more than they wanted. Stormy moods made clear thinking a real challenge. You either cared too much or were accused of ignoring those closest to you. Being as changeable as the moon's phases in one day is what upset a few individuals. A restless urgency to go where you wouldn't miss out on growth-opportunities is what caused to move often. Logic wasn't necessarily your main tool when in a stressful conflict. Toning down your response time did avoid a few embarrassing situations. Then again, it was occasionally the people you leaned on that were unpredictable, lacking stability. When you escaped from unstable circumstances you felt more in control as well as rooted, and lighter in worry.

Sun oppose Ascendant

You were a people person. Living alone wasn't your first option. Partnerships gave you a sense of importance. You did need to watch out for making relationships your everything. Your creative drives often were well received. This was due to knowing how to make others understand a message. Social savvy took you far. Sometimes you attracted lovers wanting all of the attention. It went better when you found a soul mate willing to split the spotlight. It was easy to find support for your aspirations. You only needed to act confident to attract the resources required. Romance had a way of drawing out your most dramatic self-expression.

Mercury square Pluto

You had a mind that could slice through any problem, like a laser beam. Mental intensity followed you into your incarnations. Sooner or later, you were faced with your shadows. Staring them down was liberating, running from them was limiting. You could be ruthless about

defending your ideas. Whatever work you performed, it was thorough. A passion for your favorite subjects and pastimes caused you to accomplish great things. When you didn't stubbornly resist those wanting to know the real you, your relationships deepened immensely. You didn't trust many people. Transcending a painful past was occasionally the catalyst to send you toward rebirth.

Mars trine Node

There was a relaxed momentum as far as pursuing your highest aspirations. This was sometimes mistaken by others as laziness, but was really an inner sense of knowing things would work out for the best. You were a source of inspiration for many. When you had a feisty nature life seemed to reach out and pull you into the right directions. When that spirit was down, you missed the cues. You were fortunate in numerous instances to dodge danger and find yourself on the trail of plenty.

Jupiter oppose Saturn

Considering your options without getting weighed down by them was the challenge. There was joy in finding professions and people that withstood the tests of time. Sorrow was the result of losing these things. You had a habit of getting very attached to whatever you focused on. Although you ran to greener pastures if you got cold feet! You were choosy about your relationships and occupations. It's almost like you lived two lives in one. A desire for freedom made you roam. But this had to be balanced with feeling grounded. You grew sad, even depressed, when terribly lonely. There was a need to let someone get close. Solitude was empowering if chosen for the right reasons. Clearly defined relationships made you happy.

Jupiter square Node

Enthusiasm was no problem, but maintaining a sense of direction was at times. You had a habit of being distracted by indulgences that took away from your concentration. There was a tendency to get so devoted to other people's causes you forgot about your own. When you were decisive and disciplined, you could run circles around others and get twice as much done. Your inspiring enthusiasm made others believe in themselves. If you had a lack of faith was when you suffered the most. You didn't care to be that disciplined. Routines made you uneasy. Painting the truth with various colors of convenience made those closest to you angry. Your willingness to make good on a promise was the best way to win back your friends. You did have an inclination to gamble.

Jupiter square Midheaven

Being organized wasn't an immediate impulse. You liked to act first and think later. Following hunches occasionally paid off, but sometimes didn't. Exaggerating your qualifications made others not believe you. Your dramatic side didn't bother anyone as much as promising more than could be delivered. Excess indulgences made discipline a challenge. You found absolute happiness when tapping into talents that earned you recognition. You realized

eventually that real effort would take you to where you needed to be.

Saturn square Midheaven

Defining your ambitions in a way that satisfied your own needs versus those of others produced conflict. Being your own person was a struggle. You had greater success when being open to divergent views and staying flexible. It was refusing to change that made you miserable, and feeling isolated. Proving your self-reliance to yourself was a drive. You preferred being in control of your own destiny because people seemed to let you down. Sometimes you felt the best way to get a job done was doing it yourself. Learning to delegate responsibility didn't come naturally. Discipline was accomplished mainly through not fearing a project or task. The prospect of failing made you nervous, even panicky. Getting encouragement from others helped you get through a lack of confidence. Lightening up, flowing with experiences, not forcing the outcome of situations, was wisdom indeed!

Neptune square Node

Your ideals had to be in alignment with your major life purposes or you were never at ease. Perfection was a driving energy. Dealing with everyday reality was tough. You needed structure but defied it. The exception being when you found the life directions that gave you inspirational focus. Irrational fears sometimes kept you from showing your ability. Developing sound reasoning powers was as essential as having the faith to pursue your dreams.

Neptune oppose Ascendant

You were impressionable. The test came in seeing someone for what they really represented. Wearing rose colored glasses didn't make for reality testing. However, when you found a soul mate, life was wonderful. A search for a higher power inspired you. Finding ways to satisfy the demands of your idealism was no easy challenge. The muses spoke through you forcefully when you acknowledged them. Not letting others talk you out of your dreams was vital to your fulfillment.

Midheaven oppose Node

You weren't one to let anyone stop you from realizing your full potential. There was a dilemma though when it came to balancing your need for intimacy and closeness with that of a profession. You had some tough decisions to make regarding these two areas. In some lives you felt the need to have strong support systems in place and valued a stable home environment. There were incarnations when you managed to have both or simply were happy in choosing one over the other. The trickiest times were when you wanted both but keeping them was testy. Another theme worth mentioning was that you attracted responsibility and had to be careful in choosing your commitments wisely. Running from them made problems worse. You preferred to be in control rather than having to answer to others. Authority figures got on your nerves if they didn't respect your decisions. You could be quite the family person and yet be totally dedicated to a career. Finding the middle ground between the two was the key to happiness.

Ascendant square Node

You had a tendency to either react quickly to taking advantage of an opportunity or to stew in a quandary. You felt conflict in trying to fight off strong willed individuals to pursue your own dreams. Being your own person wasn't comfortable if giving into the expectations of others continuously. Then again, if you always demanded your own way, nobody stayed your friend for all seasons. Finding the right roles that best expressed your potential was a fight to the finish. This gave you strength. Patience was a key to making solid, well-conceived decisions.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.**Aries on 2nd house:**

A pioneering spirit colored your view of money and possessions in past incarnations. An impulse to purchase what delivered immediate satisfaction was typical. Fighting for your values was another trait. There was fight in you when it came to preserving what meant the most to you! Exercising patience in the midst of testy circumstances was not easy. Taking risks needed to be kept reasonable.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.**Pisces on 3rd house:**

You followed your feelings and intuitive impulses. They guided your perceptions. If emotionally confused, you didn't think so clearly. So it was important not to let other's opinions bother you. Your mind worked romantically. Looking through rose colored glasses did lead you astray from time to time. Then again your mental impulses could tune right into the truth. Accepting what you really saw took courage. Because you could detect what was really going on in the minds of other people, you had to decide just how much you wanted to know. Denial kept you from clarity. Speaking directly to those you loved came with practice. Standing up to your critics and adversaries grew when you embraced with greater fortitude your most cherished ideals. Certain causes spoke directly to your heart. You absorbed a lot of other people's energies so downtime was essential. Guilt was a shadow that was tormenting. When you found the faith to let go of self-doubt, the heavens seemed to shine down with good fortune.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.**Aquarius on 4th house:**

Closeness and distance was a challenge. You liked the feeling of companionship and a trusted partner. Then again, you liked your breathing room. Balancing these two tendencies

wasn't easy. You had to find the courage to let your unique ideas be known. Your sense of security leaned on your determination to be a free and independent thinker. Showing others you needed them brought them closer. If you became too distant emotionally, life was a lonelier place. Clearly established dependency needs proved wise.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.**Capricorn on 5th house:**

You tended to work hard first and play later. Eventually you learned that it was best to reward yourself for giving your best efforts. Through a carefully disciplined approach you did accomplish a great deal. Stage fright bothered you when put into situations out of your element. You were more fun when not so serious. Depression got the best of you when too attached to the results of your actions. Nobody wins all of the time wasn't easy for you to accept. Your strength shined through when the going got tough. You did see that choosing your battles wisely was the road to increased happiness. Power struggles were commonplace. Sensitivity about your reputation was another trait. It meant a lot to you to be known as an authentic person.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.**Capricorn on 6th house:**

You applied yourself seriously to the job in front of you. Discipline along with a hard work ethic guided much of your thinking. Becoming a workaholic occurred. You did need to discover that delegating work to others did lighten your load. A tendency to try to do too much of the work on your own grew burdensome. Trusting others to help became a wise policy. You could be tenacious about solving a problem. The trick was figuring out when enough was enough. Learning new trends and habits didn't come easily due to allegiance to the past. Your determination got you over obstacles.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.**Sagittarius on 7th house:**

You liked adventurous types. Falling in love was exhilarating. An attraction to broad-minded individuals was a reality. You liked being with someone sharing your values and world-view. An idealistic nature colored the lenses through which you perceived a lover. This doesn't mean you were gullible. You realized that not everyone could be trusted. Your belief in people raised their spirits. Relationships that offered growth caught your attention. Lovers could be changeable and at times not so reliable. You may have had too much faith in them. If someone didn't try to control you, he or she scored points. You did sometimes have a grass is greener outlook, causing you to suddenly leave a lover. Fun loving individuals lifted you out of your lows. You became bored with those that were negatively addicted. Luck more often than not brought you good fortune in meeting the right people at the right time. You could be spontaneous in moving toward a door of opportunity. A gregarious nature brought you into contact with an interesting assortment of peers.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.**Libra on 8th house:**

You liked people that were fair-minded regarding power. Knowing you had the freedom to make your own decisions meant a lot to you. Being treated as an equal in partnerships, was something you were extra sensitive about. You took romantic commitments seriously. Vague definition in partnerships confused you. Lovers needed to really prove they cared about you. Trust was the big challenge.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.**Virgo on 9th house:**

A sober philosophy about life is what you showed. If someone wanted a grounded opinion, you were definitely the person to ask. You preferred to spend your time on practical concerns. It's not that you didn't have any idealism or intuition, but it's more likely these two traits were not the first choice. You carefully weighed your options before making decisions. Impulsive individuals made you nervous. Even your recklessness appears to have been well thought out. Conquering negative thinking made the present more enjoyable as did maintaining a broader perspective.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.**Leo on 10th house:**

Leadership roles made you feel you were in the driver's seat. People either liked the way you took control of situations or were angered by it. Either way, you did exert a very visible presence when you were determined to make your ideas known. Taking pride in your accomplishments defined you. What might have gone wrong with this dynamic energy? It was not knowing when to stop forcing your will on others. A steady and focused movement toward ambitions was your usual mode of operation. Having things on your own terms was what you preferred. People wished you didn't always have to get your own way. Finding a big enough stage to act out roles was a constant challenge. You had to fight those trying to limit your self-expression. Not having your talents noticed was always a bitter pill to swallow. You normally didn't wait for others to take notice. You were delighted when loved ones showed unconditional faith in your abilities. You showed impatience with those doubting you. Lack of success wasn't in your vocabulary.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.**Cancer on 11th house:**

You were quite sensitive about getting support for your goals. It only caused trouble when you didn't follow through, due to looking over your shoulder for approval. You did alienate others if you grew too resentful without good reason for there not always agreeing with you. You relied on your intuition greatly to guide you into the future. A fear of the future could be cast aside when you released your creative power. Sometimes it was overcoming irrational fears that brought out your self-confidence. Learning to not overly intellectualize your feelings was a test.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.**Cancer on 12th house:**

You preferred not being all that visible. When there was vagueness in making your needs known, confusion resulted. You tended to idealize your closest relationships. This did lead you to sometimes expect too much from people. It was your inspiring belief in those you cared about that did get them to attempt great things. Learning how to regulate closeness and distance in relating to others kept you balanced. Having confidence in your deepest beliefs brought you fulfillment.

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Saturn retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had much to learn regarding flexibility versus rigidity. These two opposites were a sore spot of contention. A tendency to get extremely focused when you enjoyed a role was a past pattern. You were happier when feeling in control of your life. Knowing when to show vulnerability and when to show a tough set of armor was wisdom indeed! Some thought you lacked ambition. What they didn't see working behind the scenes was your inner search to find professions and directions that seemed worth the effort. An inclination toward becoming a one-dimensional workaholic was a potential trap. Remembering that life was a multidimensional panorama made for happier times. There was a need to steer clear of icebergs that brought depression and feelings of rejection. Responding with courage to your commitments lessened your anxiety about them. It was in not letting fear keep you from the love and success you painfully wanted that you reached the highest of milestones.
